

## HIGHER EXECUTIVE OFFICERS PERMANENT (PANEL) REQUIRED

The Adoption Authority of Ireland (AAI) is a statutory body established on 1 November 2010 and the legislation underpinning the Authority is the Adoption Act 2010.

The AAI is undergoing significant growth as it takes on new and expanding functions as a result of new Birth Information and Tracing Legislation.

We currently have a number of exciting opportunities at all levels as we grow and transform our organisation.

The AAI is seeking to recruit Higher Executive Officers (HEOs), based in Ballsbridge, Dublin 4. Blended working is available with these positions subject to the nature of the duties.

Successful applicants will be placed on a panel to fill current and future vacancies for a period of up to 18 months.

HEOs in the AAI are key members of the mid-management team within the organisation and support the senior management team in completing stated objectives under Corporate and Business Plans. A HEO can be involved in policy development; project management; management of an effective work unit; ensuring clear identification of roles and responsibilities and motivating staff.

The HEO salary scale ranges from €50,848 to €64,038 per annum (inclusive of two long term increments) for a 37 hour week.

Please note the starting pay will be at the minimum point of the scale as per Government Circular E100/8/82. Exceptional circumstances may apply to candidates with current service in the Civil/Public Services.

Annual Leave: 29 days per annum on the basis of a five-day week and is exclusive of public holidays.
